Technical Training

LRTT is an EASA Part 147 Approved Basic Training Organisation based in the UK. In addition to providing EASA Part 66 Category A1, A3, B1.1, B1.3, & B2 courses, LRTT also provides skill enhancement training such as composite repair, electrical hand skills, structural repair and legislative updates such as human factors, aviation legislation and EWIS.

LRTT offers fully approved and modular helicopter courses focused on the needs of the client and the individual. Courses can be studied individually or in multiples and in any sequence either at LRTT facilities or at your site should you wish. LRTT facilities include a fully operational BO-105 helicopter for "on aircraft" practical training, a purpose built training centre, a sheet metal shop, composite workshop and fully equipped classrooms.

EASA Part 66 Category A3 and B1.3 Helicopter Courses

LRTT offers fully approved basic courses for ab-initio students, modular courses for experienced engineers and a wide range of skills courses across a variety of subject matter areas. The EASA Part-66 Category A licence provides certification for scheduled line maintenance and basic defect rectification tasks and can also be delivered as an apprenticeship. By training your staff to Category A licence, you can benefit from significant advantages in cost overheads and manpower flexibility.

The category B1.3 licence can also be delivered in a modular format or as a fully approved course. Those already holding a B1.1 licence need only complete one module, M12, to extend their licence to a B1.3 helicopter licence in addition to completing the work experience required. LRTT also offers sub modular options for those that need to lift limitations from a restricted licence.

As an industry embedded training company, LRTT does not have a set academic year and utilise a flexible, cost effective approach to deliver a bespoke training solution designed to fit with operational requirements of the client or individual. Courses focus on the needs of the individual and allow students to study flexibly around their other commitments.
